Open Board Positions

The positions of President, Vice President, and two At-Large Board positions are up for election at the Annual Conference on April 18-19!

The President and Vice President serve for a **2 year term** and can stand for reelection. At-Large Board members serve for a **3 year term**, and can stand for 2 consecutive terms.
